Please remember there is no direct elevator access to the sanctuary basement. We will begin at 8:00 a.m. and many hands will make this a much easier task so please plan to help for even just a few hours if possible. #### **Heritage Hall Renovation**

Beginning May 28, Heritage Hall will be under construction. While the church office staff will be relocated, the church phone number and staff emails will remain the same. To contact the church office, please call 260-423-2496 and listen for the prompts to connect you to the individual you are looking for. Member access to the church office staff will be very limited and on an appointment basis only in order to minimize disruption to the IN District Office during this time. Restrooms will remain available during the entire construction process for use during services. Access will be through the west cloister hallway. No other access will be available during construction. The elevator and east cloister entrances will be closed. Lastly, the west 1/2 of the parking lot will be unavailable for parking as it will be used for construction material storage and project staging. Please plan to park on the street, at the District office, or the remaining parking spaces in the north lot. Handicap accessible parking will be on the south side of church at the circle drive where the ramp is located.
