Located 25 miles Northwest of St. Paul Lutheran Church Please allow 40 minutes travel time!

Leave St. Paul and travel NORTH on Barr Street.

Turn RIGHT onto Jefferson Blvd

Turn Left onto Lafayette (US 27 North)

Follow US 27 and US 3 North to the I-69 interchange (approx 4 miles)

Take the ramp for I-69 WEST


Travel on I-69 WEST for approx. 1.5 miles

Take exit for US 30 WEST

Travel on US 30 WEST for approx 1/2 mile and exit right onto US 33 Take US 33 NORTH/NORTHWEST for approx. 13.5 miles After you leave Churubusco, IN start looking for "Green Center" Sign

or look for the Pro Systems Company on the left hand side Turn RIGHT at this sign or when you see Pro Systems onto County Road 650E and head NORTH

CR 650E becomes County Road 300E
Kramer Park is approximately 5 miles from US 33 on CR 300E
Entrance to Kramer Park is on the LEFT side of the road.
